Beyer's office passed along contacts with Reps. GT Thompson (PA) and Aaron Bean (FL) who both expressed interest in preserving the perimeter to ensure their constituents can maintain their non-stop flights to DCA. She thought they might be interested in signing on to a broader inside the perimeter letter.

GT Thompson is from Northwestern PA and it looks like his district could feed Pittsburgh, Buffalo, and Cleveland as the largest approximate airports. Bean is from Jacksonville and JAX is in his district. I don't know if you've recently made contact with either of these offices but, I would be happy to set up some time to chat with each office.

Additionally, they were contacted by Rep. Khanna (CA) who would like to see the perimeter maintained. To this end do we envision that there are likely outside the perimeter members who might stand with us? If so, would a letter from that group, whatever the size, be of any value?
