Based on Annual Service Volume (ASV) delay analysis, we find that an increase of 20 daily round trip operations would increase delay by 25.9%, and an increase of 25 daily round trip operations would increase delay by 33.2% DCA.	
(Before sending this memo, FAA sent me an email estimating much higher delay increases. These figures supersede those and are the ones we should use.)
